


Sctripture associatied with the land of Melek:


Alma 8:3 And it came to pass in the commencement of the tenth year of the reign of the judges over the people of Nephi, that Alma departed from thence and took his journey over into the land of Melek, on the west of the briver Sidon, on the west by the borders of the wilderness.

Alma 8:6...he (Alma) traveled three days' journey on the north of the land of Melek; and he came to a city which was called Ammonihah.

Alma 35:13 And the people of Ammon departed out of the land of Jershon, and came over into the land of Melek, and gave place in the land of Jershon for the armies of the Nephites... Correlations between Melek (Aquateca) and other Book of Mormon Locations:

- Melek is west of the Sidon River
- Aquateca matches the timeline of the Melek.
- The Nephites repositioned the Ammonites just to the west of Zarahemla so their armies could contend with the Lamanites.
